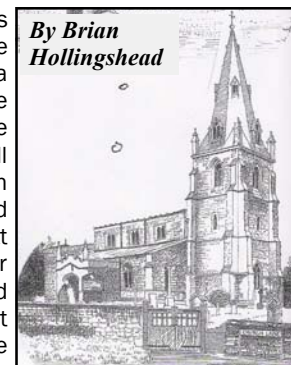
## SCALFORD PARISH CHURCH
