## Goadby Marwood Post Office over Christmas

## Postal Scam



Leicestershire Constabulary is warning members of the public about a postal scam which is operating nationally. Cards are being posted through letterboxes from a company called PDS (Parcel Delivery Service). The cards suggest that the company was unable to deliver a parcel to your address and urge you to contact them on 0906 6611911, which is a premium rate number. This scam is currently under investigation by ICSTIS (the premium rate service regulator).

The company also make contact by telephone, stating that the same company are wanting you to contact them, as they have a parcel for you and need to arrange delivery. Please do not respond.

## GIFT AID

Like most of the other churches in the group, Eastwell now has Gift Aid envelopes. If you have attended a service there recently, you may have noticed the yellow envelopes on the pews.

If you are a taxpayer, the church can reclaim the amount of tax paid on any donations, which considerably increases the church's income.

We discussed "The Kite Runner" by Khaled Hosseini. This book was admired by everyone, although as it explores the recent history of Afghanistan, it is not a happy read. The story follows the life of Amir from Childhood in Afghanistan, with his father and best friend from a lower caste, to adulthood. An incident changes Amir's life and that of his friend forever; they split and Amir ends up in America when the Russians invade.

A few years later Amir returns to Afghanistan under the Taliban to try and make amends for events in his past, and he discovers things about his family history and himself which explain his relationship with his father.

This is a story well told, and it is very informative about the recent history of Afghanistan, causing us to have an appreciation of the situation in the country when it is mentioned in the news. The book gives a good insight into a different culture and deals with traditions and relationships very well. We awarded it 4 out of 5 possible stars.
