

#### **Parish Council Meeting**

Thursday, 10th May 2007, Goadby Marwood Village Hall, 7.00 pm. Annual Parish Meeting, followed by monthly meeting.

Parish Council meetings are open to members of the public; agendas and minutes are on the village notice boards the Friday before the meeting, or on the following website: www.leicestershireparishcouncil s.org/eaton/

At the EPC meeting on 8th March 2007, Mike Sheldrake, District Engineer, Highways Department, Leicestershire County Council, made the following important points, which the general public in Eaton and the surrounding parishes should be aware of.

#### Reporting accidents

To justify investment in road safety improvements, the Council relies on police statistics. Parishioners should report accidents to the police, otherwise it can be difficult to build the case for action. For example, there have been a number of accidents at the Green Lane/Waltham Lane crossroads, but it seems few have been reported.

#### **Community Speedwatch**

The Community Speed Watch initiative is proving very effective in helping local

communities take action to reduce speeding traffic. He encouraged EPC to become involved (for further details, see the call for volunteers on this page).

#### **Weight Limit Restrictions**

Leicestershire County Council has provided funding for policing of weight restrictions. Parishioners can report infringements to the local police, but the police need to know specific details, such as date, time, place, registration or company name for commercial vehicles.


#### CALL FOR FURTHER COUNCILLORS

Melton Borough Council, which manages the parish council elections on 3rd May, received 4 nominations for Eaton Parish Council: Molly Gatehouse, Mike Whiston and Beryl Wilson (existing councillors) and Alan Hewson. This means they are elected unopposed. However, this leaves two vacancies which need to be filled in order for the Parish Council to represent electors in a democratic way. #### COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH

This originated in Avon and Somerset due to an increased demand from the public for greater involvement in reducing the speed of vehicles through local villages. The scheme requires between 6-12 local volunteers to be trained to record vehicles travelling above police guidelines, with hand held speed detection devices. Working in pairs, they monitor speed and forward a log of vehicles to the police. The police then consider whether to send warning letters, and will target persistent offenders for enforcement. volunteers do not engage with drivers or have any involvement other than monitor the speed of the traffic.
