UPPER BROUGHTON'S 25TH ANNIVERSARY ART SHOW 12th to 14th OCTOBER

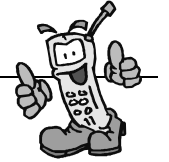

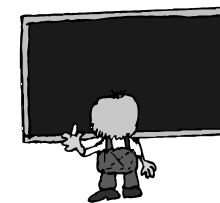

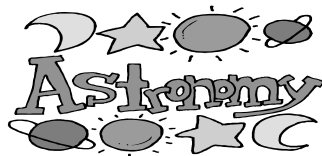
