

Harvest Donations

Each of our churches makes donations to charity at harvest time. Over recent years Water Aid, Send a Cow, Dove Cottage, the Air Ambulance, Teso (Uganda), Secondary Girls Education Fund, Samaritans Purse have all benefited from your generosity.

This year we have asked, in the light of the floods and foot and mouth, that some of the money goes to the ARC-Addington Fund, administered by the Arthur Rank Centre. This Centre is a partnership between the Royal Agricultural Society of England, the national churches and the Rank Foundation.

During the national foot and mouth epidemic in 2001, at the request of the Archbishop of Canterbury, the Centre set up in the ARC Addington Fund is now part of a new amalgamation called the Farming Help Partnership, which also includes Farm Crisis Network (FCN) and the Royal Agricultural Benevolent Institution (RABI).

Each of the partner charities provides different but complementary help and support to meet a wide range of needs in the farming community. The highlighted aim of the Farming Help Partnership is to help to address the many combinations of problems now faced by farmers, including stress, housing and financial difficulties.

May I thank you in advance for your generosity in this year that has been particularly difficult for the farming community.




