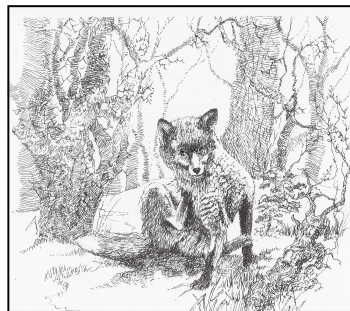

Leicestershire County Council FREE TREES



A new free Tree Scheme for farmers and rural landowners has been launched as part of the LCC's tree planting initiative. The scheme is aimed at replacing lost trees in rural areas of the county.

In addition to increasing its own planting programme on road verges, the LCC will be providing trees for farmers and landowners to plant in hedgerows, field boundaries, field corners and in parkland areas. The scheme does not cover private gardens.

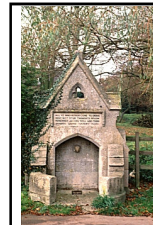

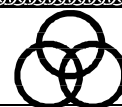
