#### Street Lighting

The natural lifespan of the street lighting in the villages is gradually coming to its end. As the fittings age they need replacing more often and this obviously increases costs. The Parish Council is mindful not only of the increasing cost of energy, but also of the effect all-night lighting has on the environment.

The energy companies now offer the option of providing times lighting, which means that street-lights do not have to remain on all night. This facility is particular to each light so not all lights have to have the same settings and, if

necessary, some can remain on all night, eg. those in particularly sensitive areas. The adoption of this facility would address the issues of both cost and the environment: this will not happen immediately, but as old equipment is replaced.

**Before proceeding further, the Parish Council would welcome any opinions that parishioners may have; in the absence of any response the Parish Council will proceed as it feels appropriate.**

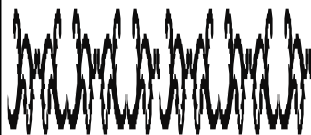

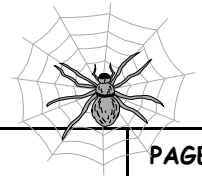
