

SCALFORD CHURCHYARD

Children have been seen climbing on the church wall and also on the memorial stone. The Parish Council would like to know the names of any child/children involved, and wish to urge anyone who does know to pass the names of the offenders—anonymously, if necessary—to any member of the Council. Repairs to the church wall can be very costly and involve obtaining a faculty from the Diocese, which is an extremely lengthy process. Also, children may not be aware of the distress such disrespect for a memorial causes.

CASH BOOST FOR VOLUNTEER HISTORIANS

The Adult Learning Challenge Fund was launched this year (by the Museums, Libraries and Archives Council), and Melton Carnegie Museum has recently been granted nearly £5,000 for volunteer historians to develop workshops and expand their skills.


