





CONFIRMATION

Thursday, 22nd April, 7.30 pm All Saints Church, Asfordby Led by Bishop Tim

A Confirmation Service is an opportunity for anyone who is not already confirmed, to publically declare their faith in Jesus Christ, and their intention to live a life of responsible and committed discipleship.

This might be because they are new to the Christian faith or because they are now at a point in their own Christian journey when they wish to make this step.

The origins of the service go right back to the early Church, when it was difficult for bishops to get around. New converts to the faith would be baptised by their local priest and then later, when the Bishop was in the

region, the Bishop would through prayer and the laying on of hands ask God to give them power through the Holy Spirit to enable them to live in this way.
