#### **BEVERLEY'S SABBATICAL**

On 5th September, whilst the excellent Barry Hill is speaking to the joint congregations at Waltham (go and listen to him if you can and you will enjoy and be challenged by what he has to say), David and I will be on our way to three months of journeying with God on a Sabbatical break.

Clergy can apply for a Sabbatical every seven years, but in 16 years of ministry this is the first one I have had. It is, as the name suggests, a time to get away from usual responsibilities, time deadlines and tricky decisions and get some Sabbath rest.

Rest takes different forms for different people and one of my early decisions was that this sabbatical should include time with my husband David, who has also worked tirelessly beside me in the church and in the hospitality of the Vicarage (and of course the garden at Waltham vicarage). He is taking time out from supply teaching and some unpaid leave from a school in Nottingham and for two months we are going off in our touring caravan to rural England.



# FRIENDS OF CHERNOBYL'S CHILDREN

#### PLEASE CAN YOU HELP?

We are hosts for the Friends of Chernobyl Children's Charity (East Leicestershire). The children come to the  $\Pi$ United Kingdom from Belarus for a month a year for 5 years. The visit improves their life expectancy as well as providing a number of opportunities and experiences they would otherwise not encounter. The children are still affected by the Chernobyl Disaster which happened over 20 years ago. They eat few fruit and vegetables and drink little or no milk as in their country it is contaminated.

They come from very poor backgrounds. When they arrive in England they usually have very few clothes. often arriving with a small rucksack or even a carrier bag. There will be 10-12 in the group that comes in September this year. We are looking for donations of any autumn or winter clothes suitable for girls and boys between the ages of 7 and 10 that you or


