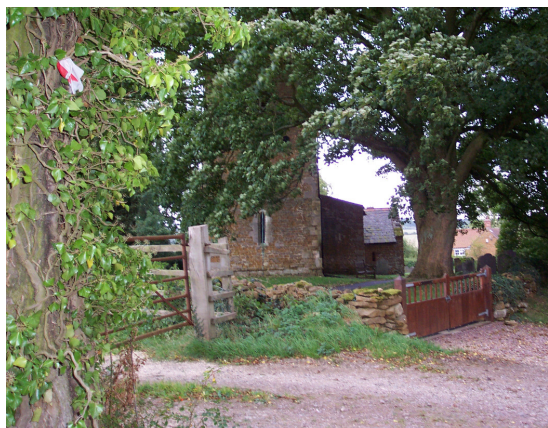

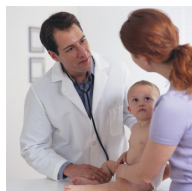

LONG CLAWSON MEDICAL PRACTICE

The Practice has recently established a Patient Participation Group: - in case you don't already know a PPG is a group of patients interested in health and healthcare issues, who want to get involved with and support the running of their local GP Practice.

Like most PPG's yours at Long Clawson includes members of practice staff. The group meets at regular intervals and in our early meetings we have identified that the PPG can really help the practice get messages and information to its patients.

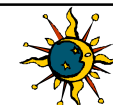
