Many thanks to everyone who sponsored me so generously on my bike ride in support of Eastwell Church in the Annual Ride & Stride Day run by the Leicestershire Historic Churches Preservation Trust on Saturday, 10th September.

As planned, I managed to visit 20 local churches within the day—21 including Eastwell—and am very pleased to report that I raised a grand total of £113.00 (which will be increased to £141.25 with Gift Aid): half that sum will go to Eastwell Church and half to the organising body.
