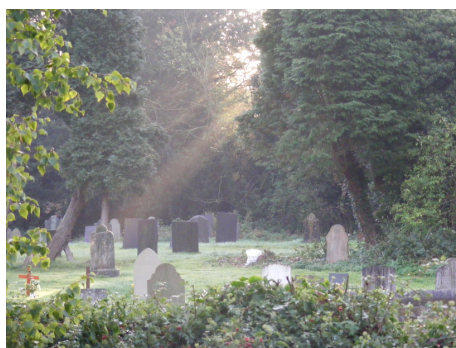

A MESSAGE FROM THE LCC TRADING STANDARDS SERVICE

This service is committed to protecting residents, particularly those who are vulnerable, from unscrupulous doorstep criminals offering home improvement services, such as paving, landscaping and roofing work. Residents are often pressured or intimidated into accepting a poor standard of work for an extortionate cost. Work is often unnecessary and sometimes money is paid for work that hasn't been done.

Advice to all residents is always: (1) do not open the door to unexpected callers; (2) do not let strangers into your home; (3) do not be pressured into buying goods and services on the doorstep; (4) remember, rogue traders use glossy printed leaflets and wear smart clothes; (5) IF IN DOUBT, KEEP THEM OUT! If you suspect rogue trading in your area, please call the Citizens Advice Consumer Helpline and Trading Standards on 0854 04 05 08.

Bus transport changes. In light of the proposed changes we would like to stand with the Surgery to alert the LCC that their recent proposal will have a detrimental effect on patients travelling to the surgery by bus.

We are proposing that the bus should run on an hourly basis through the morning, rather than two hourly, and start earlier. The changes would mean that the first bus would not arrive in Long Clawson until 10.18 am, which is impractical for Open Access Surgery.

Summer holiday vaccinations. Travel assessment forms can be collected from reception; following completion and a check on your vaccination record, the surgery will advise whether or not you need additional vaccinations for your destination. Most vaccinations are required at least 4 weeks prior to travelling, so when you book your holiday, book your vaccination. Some are free of charge; others, such as yellow fever, rabies and anti-malaria tablets are chargeable.

The surgery also offers written information on sun care, altitude sickness, first aid kits, anti-malaria sprays, water safety and sexual health.

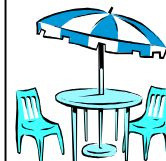

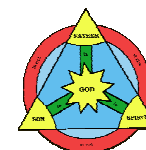

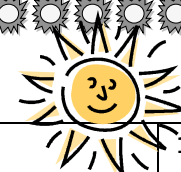
