Defibrillators for Villages in the Parish

The Parish Council apologise for having to
change the location of the last meeting from
Goadby Marwood to Eastwell Village Hall at
short notice. This was caused by flooding in
Goadby on the day. Considering the circum-

stances, the meeting was quite well attended and the demonstration by Martin Fagin from
the Community Heartbeat Trust was very informative.

Martin demonstrated how easy it was to use a defibrillator, but emphasised that alone was
not sufficient, as it needed one person to administer physical heart massage and another
to ring the ambulance service and fetch the defibrillator. It appeared that an ideal location
for housing the equipment was red telephone boxes, as BT would not only give them to the
Parish Council but pay for the electricity supply that is needed to maintain the equipment.
Whilst a number of people were interested in how to use the equipment and possibly
inspect it on a weekly basis, no donations towards the cost were offered.

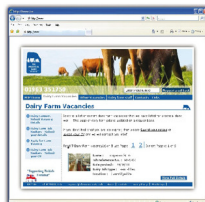

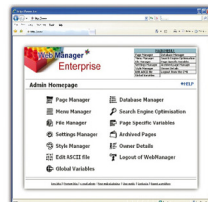
