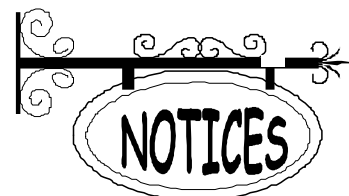

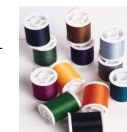

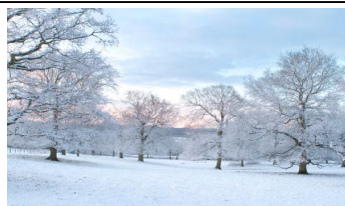
## The Last Waltz
