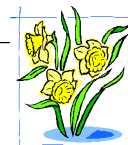

UPDATE ON SCALFORD CHURCH APPEAL FUND

Now that the builders have started the work on the church, it is hoped to publish an update each month of the Appeal Fund.

We started February with £56,650.69 in the fund. During the month a total of £6,251 has been spent on an asbestos survey, work to cover the organ to protect it and the first stage payment to the architect. Money coming in has included £270 from the sale of church property, £315 from the quiz, £1,050 from the sponsored 100 mile bike ride, £245 from the mediaeval banquet and a grant of £1,750 from the Allchurches Trust - a total of £3,630. This left a total in the fund at the beginning of March of £54,029.69.

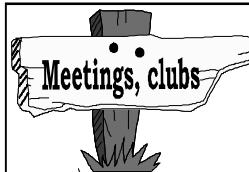

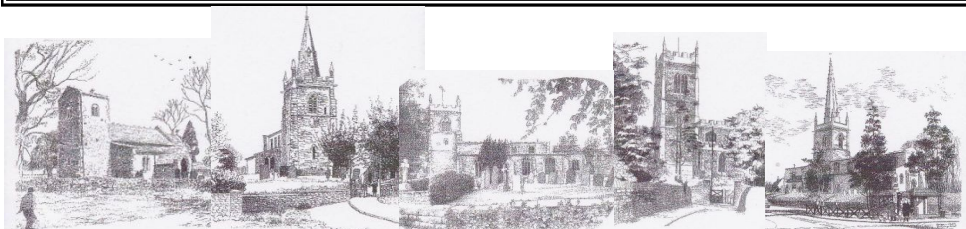
