Chairman's Annual Report. We give below the Chairman's report to the Annual Parish Meeting held in April.

The council throughout the year have managed to achieve most of the goals that were set before them for the year 2012-13, staying within the budget set for the period. The council allocated £1,000.00 for each village defibrillator, with parishioners raising the remainder. Goadby Marwood has theirs already installed in the old village telephone box; both Eaton and Eastwell defibrillators have been ordered and will be installed in the near future.

Maintenance has been carried out in Eaton Cemetery and the churchyard with regular mowing and general tidying up. The overhanging trees in the cemetery have been cut back to open up the right hand side for future burials.

The booster station at Eastwell has had further planting of shrubs with the surrounding verge mowed, and tidied as and when needed.

A new litter bin was purchased and installed in the centre of Eastwell next to the seat.

The Council's donation of £1,000 to provide toilets for Eastwell church has been taken up.

**Update of
SCALFORD CHURCH
APPEAL FUND**

Since last month the builders
have been progressing well with
the work in church, and everything
is on schedule for the re-opening on
7th July.

A decision has been made to have
the whole church decorated and not
just patching up of the walls where
the pews were removed. This will
cost in the region of another
£12,000, but will be partially offset
by the project running at the
moment at about £4,000 under
budget. It will be much easier to
erect scaffolding to do this work
before the new screens are put in
place for the servery, meeting room,
etc., and before pews are replaced in
the church. The church was last
decorated in the 1980s.

Fund paid into the account were
£2,500 received from the Jack
Patson Trust and £85 from a car
boot sale of the leftover bric a brac
from the jumble sale. Expenses
paid out amount to around £660
and the total in the fund at the end
of April was £56,332.37.

The precept has been set at £12,500 once again with a further grant £750.00 being given by the Borough Council. Throughout the year councillors have attended several Area Forum, Parish Liaison and Planning meetings and have responded to the Borough Council Planning department re site visits.

Allotments, except for one plot, have all been taken up again by either new or existing tenants with the revised Tenancy Agreement now in place.

Mowing contracts have been awarded for the coming year with the lowest of three quotes given.

Finally I would like to thank all Councillors for their support throughout the year. Also to the clerk for all the hard work he has put in, not only at Council meetings but for all his work behind the scenes in attempting to sort out the Herbage Land Registry.
