### SCALFORD CHURCH PROJECT UPDATE

The work in church is now complete and the re-opening due to take place on 6th and 7th July. The church council members are delighted with the improvements made and hope everyone will share their enthusiasm. The church should now be warm and much more welcoming for worshippers and visitors. After the re-opening the church will be open during the daytime as usual for those who wish to pray, or just enjoy the tranquillity of a quiet space.

Although the work is finished the fundraising will continue. There have been no fundraising events during June and the next event will be the quiz on 6th July. The fund at the end of May amounted to £46,391, so no loan money has as yet been taken. However large amounts will soon have to be paid to the builders and loan money from the Diocese used. This money will need to be repaid and so a continued effort is needed. The church members very much hope the village will continue to support us so well, particularly as there are other works that need to be carried out on the church in the near future to maintain the building.

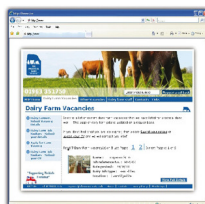
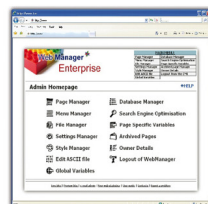

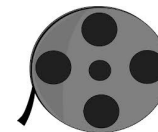
