CHURCH OF ENGLAND - CONFIRMATION

In the Bible and in many of the newer churches (by this I mean post Reformation onwards!), teenagers and adults are baptised when they are old enough to tell people their faith story and to accept the challenge of the Christian journey.

In the Church of England, which is both a pre and a post Reformation church, it is not that simple. We inherited a policy of baptising babies soon after birth, which was in fact quite sensible because of high infant mortality. In the New Testament church whole families along with their slaves were baptised when the man in the family became a member of the early church. So everyone has an

became a member of the early church. So everyone has an authentic way of baptising, but two separate ways of doing it.

In the Ironstone Village churches we baptise (Christen) quite a few babies, a handful of children and a few adults every year (12 between now and the middle of June). Then over the years we lose touch with many of them as they move away, or as a result of interest in football, swimming, ballet, horses, etc. etc.

So here is an offer to people of faith who never got the chance to be confirmed.

Confirmation is a teenager or an adult saying "I now understand the promises made for me by my Godparents and I want to take them for myself and set myself on a Christian faith journey". The Confirmation service is straight forward and very moving and Confirmations always get a Bishop into the local churches (unless people decide to be confirmed in our new improved cathedral instead).

Having said all this, my question is very simple. If you missed out on confirmation for any reason, then please get in touch and we will find out more about it together, and then those who want to can be confirmed.
