VALE POLICING WITH PCSO PALMER

Inconsiderate parking is a concern that many local residents have been bringing to the attention of the Vale Police Team. This has mainly been in the streets surrounding schools at start and close of school day and is causing a few close encounters. Before this becomes a major issue I would like to take this opportunity to warn people of the dangers of parking across zigzag lines or close to junctions.



If you are driving along a road and vehicles are double parked, parked close to the junction or parked half on the pavement, can you honestly see what is coming out from within? Can you see the small child who has dropped his ball into the road and wants to collect it? Can you see the vehicle trying to pull out onto the road to drop their child off as well? I would suggest the answer is no. Please consider where you are leaving your vehicle, even if only for a short while, as this could pose a danger to young children and other members of the community.

The changes to the policing structure across Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland have now been in place for a full calendar month, and the success of the new operating system is already apparent. The visibility of local neighbourhood officers across the County has risen 40%. On a local level the Vale has seen a 5 year low in terms of crime figures. This is currently down 35% compared to 5 years ago. Again, this shows that your local police are tackling crime constantly, keeping the Vale a safe place to live, work and visit.




