The Village News

T alking about the Village News, over the past year it has become increasingly difficult to squeeze everything in,. Most issues are chock-a-block, in spite of leaving out some things and editing others.

I don't think it feasible, cost-wise, to go into another 4 x A5 pages, as the whole thing is run on a wing and a prayer, and relies purely on voluntary donations (see left): it never ceases to amaze me how they come in year by year (incidentally the first issue was either December 1988 or January 1989, can't remember which). Also the printing cost has just risen from £75 per month to £80.

So maybe this is just a plea to keep notices and articles as brief as possible. I think people tend to notice small displays rather than reams of text (like this one!). It's also worth remembering that printed A5 sheets can be inserted and delivered with the Village News. There's no cost for charities, voluntary groups, etc., but I do charge £20 for businesses (which I use to offset the cost of cartridges). Also, of course, it's up to you to print them/have them printed
