**LONG CLAWSON MEDICAL PRACTICE
AND PHARMACY**
PPG WEEK 6th to 10th JUNE 2016
FEEDBACK

This year we focused on the following topics in conversations with patients in the waiting room and listened to those brought up by yourselves. We spoke to 123 patients throughout the week. This is what you told us:

- ♦ **Surgery website.** 12 patients used this regularly to order repeat prescriptions and make appointments. 13 patients did not know there was a website and most preferred to phone. Many were unaware that these services were available on line. Using the website for these services does free up receptionists' time as well as the phone lines. If you would like to try using the website, please go to <http://www.valemedicalgroup.co.uk/>
- ♦ **Merger.** Most patients knew of the merger with the surgeries at Woolthorpe and Stackyard, Croxton Kerrial. Of those who were unaware most had not noticed a change. Three patients thought they had to wait to see a specific doctor. There was however general agreement that overall patients understood the sense behind this move.
- ♦ **Missed appointments.** There was general outrage at the high number of missed appointments for 2015 (447). The most common response was to "fine them"! (There were worse!). A sensible course of action suggested by many was to research why these appointments were missed. Other suggestions were automated text reminders 24/48 hours before the appointment, one variation on this being that they must respond yes/no by the day of their appointment or it would be given to another patient. Patients who admitted they had missed an appointment said that they felt somewhat ashamed. Please, if you cannot keep your appointment, phone reception. No matter how late it is, it may free up a slot for someone else.
- ♦ **Memory worries.** This affects a lot of us. As a first step you can book an appointment with the nurse to discuss this with you and provide guidance.
- ♦ **Privacy.** Any patient needing to have a conversation at Reception or in the Pharmacy and would appreciate some privacy can ask to use a private room. This is also available for patients who are seriously ill. This is something which was highlighted by patients in our survey last year. We hope it is working for you

- ♦ **Pharmacy.** This was not a topic on our sheet but was brought up by a number of you. Every one appreciated being able to collect their prescriptions from the surgery and there was considerable praise for the Pharmacy delivery service. The main problem is that your medication may not be in stock. The Pharmacy should, however, be able to obtain this within 48 hours, but some medications may take longer. If this has been a problem for you, please talk to the Pharmacy staff.

There were a few suggestions for improvement, eg. more detailed information when phoning up for test results, slow correspondence between hospitals and surgery and the possibility of limiting waiting time at the surgery for very ill patients. Generally patients' comments about the surgery and those who work there were more than positive. Open access is very particularly appreciated. Other comments were: best surgery going, really good service, second to none, pleasant staff who are helpful, sympathetic and professional.

To all the patients who agreed to talk to us last week, a very big "Thank you" and to those who did not feel up to talking, we understand. We would love to hear from any of you who would like to join us in our work. We meet monthly at the surgery, and work with all the staff. We would also very much welcome any young adults, typically from years 12 and 13 to represent the views of their age group.

Our next big event will be the combined health fair and influenza vaccination clinic in October

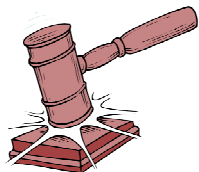

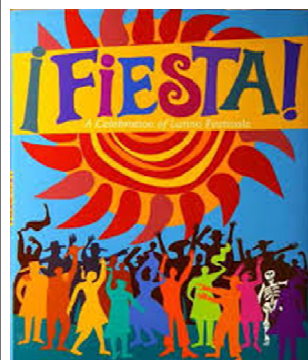
