

'Everyday Faith'

Dear Reader of the Village News,

One of the many things I enjoy about parish ministry is the opportunity to be involved with local schools. During a couple of visits made to Scalford and Waltham Primary Schools before the summer holidays, I agreed to answer questions put to me by the children during visits to their classes - a bit like *Question Time!*

They asked me why I had become a vicar, and also about what a vicar does. After I explained how I believed that God had called me to serve in this way, I tried to explain the role of a 'vicar'.

As well as some of the more obvious and visible things - eg. services in church, meetings and visits, I said how the role also involves administration (too much!), communication, teaching, leading, training, encouraging, enabling, nurturing faith, and working with others in serving the wider community.

In summing it up, I suggested that, for me, being a vicar is about being with others, and serving God.

As a vicar (technically a rector, but it's the same thing!), I especially value the privilege of sharing life's journey with others, whether it is with individuals or groups across our Ironstone villages. While there are times I wish that I had several clones so I could be in several places at once(!), I do try to respond to invitations to come and visit - so please

feel free to invite me by sending an email or phoning, and we'll fix something up.



A few weeks ago, my wife Mary and I were at Wells Cathedral to see our younger daughter Jo being ordained as a Deacon. As you can imagine, it was a very moving occasion and a real joy to be there. The word 'deacon' means 'servant', and service is at the heart of the Christian faith. The word 'ministry' means 'service', and every baptised Christian is called to be a 'minister'. While only a few may be 'ordained', all Christians are called to serve, to make a difference for God wherever we are.

In the Diocese of Leicester, our focus is on 'everyday faith'. This is about how we express our Christian faith every day, in everyday situations. It reminds us that God is interested in more than our buildings, our money, our church services. God wants us to pray, to witness, to serve, at all times and in all places.

For example, to help us focus on 'everyday prayer', in the autumn, my wife Mary is going to be leading *The Prayer Course*, and further details will be in next month's yellow pages.


