It will soon be time for the annual Ride and Stride event throughout Leicestershire. It is a very well known and popular occasion, indeed one of the highlights of the annual Christian calendar, but for those who might be new to it, let me explain a little more.

Ride & Stride sees hundreds of people, more than 500 in 2007, being sponsored for taking part in a day of cycling and walking around the county visiting many of our beautiful places of worship and being recorded by others, also sponsored, for doing so.

Half the funds raised go straight back to nominated churches and the other half to the Leicestershire Historic Churches Trust, who then give out grants to historic churches which need maintenance and restoration work. In 2007 a massive £46.200 was raised.

Ride & Stride day provides a ready made annual opportunity for your church or chapel to be open to the public. It can be linked to an event of your own: eg. exhibition or flower festival. So there's the challenge. We passionately hope you'll pick up the baton and run with it.

Over 500 Christian churches and chapels have been sent registration packs for the 2008 event. General
