



FLUTET CONCERT, EASTWELL

The following write up on the concert has been received from John Duckworth for inclusion in the Village News:

he 'Last Night of the Proms' concert on TV did not deter a goodly number of people from attending a concert at Eastwell church given by the Matthew Lynch Flute Quartet, a newly formed group of flautists playing under the name of 'FluTet'.

Along with Matthew was Amy Thompson, who, like Matthew, is another student reading music at Oxford University, together with Michelle Gill teaching for Leicestershire Arts in Education and Dana Morgan at Leicester Grammar School.

Their programme included arrangements of music, particularly of the French school, and we were treated to a delight of deft integration of parts and gentle chords played mainly in the warm middle register of the instruments. This was very sensible because when two or more flutes play loudly in harmony at the top of their registers, the vibrations they set up can create a very disturbing buzz in listeners' ears, as happened in their opening Slavonic dance by Dvorak.

When Dana Morgan flawlessly played a work entitled "Recall" by the contemporary composer Dave Heath, we found ourselves listening to a piece demanding enormous dexterity and an exceptional technique. The programme concluded with three Latin American dances and a nursery medley (demanding the use of both an alto and bass flute), which, with an encore "In the Kitchen", made a spirited end to a very enjoyable evening.
