Good News

New church marriage regulations

The Church of England has been working for some time on new criteria for marrying in parish churches. These new marriage regulations are actually designed to widen the qualifying criteria and allow more people to get married in the church of their choice. They apply with immediate effect.

In the past it was necessary for anyone who wished to be married in a particular church in the Church of England to live within that parish, or to be a 'member' of that particular parish by virtue of having one's name included ...cont

on the church electoral roll (which is not the same thing as the civil electoral roll). It was also possible for someone with a demonstrable connection to that particular church to obtain a special licence from the Archbishop of Canterbury which would permit them to be married there.

As from 1st October 2008 living in a particular parish or being a church 'member' there, will still be valid reasons for a marriage in that church, but there will be other options:

- If a person *at any time* lived in that parish for six months, or worshipped regularly there for six months, that would be a valid reason.
- If one of that person's parents *at any time during the lifetime of that person* lived in that parish for six months, or worshipped regularly there for six months, that would also be a valid reason.
- Also if a person was baptised in that parish or was presented for confirmation from that parish or if their parents or grandparents were married there.

It sounds a lot more complex but in fact opens up a whole range of possibilities. Broadly speaking, any link with the church through residence, regular worship or family connections would suffice, though as always, it is best to discuss these things with Clare or myself.

People are expected to play fair on this. Those wishing to get married may be asked

to make a statutory declaration that the information they have provided in support of their application to be married in a particular church is correct. Knowingly providing false information would constitute perjury, which is a criminal offence.

If you don't fit these criteria we have a tried and tested way of helping couples attend church so that they can qualify for the Electoral Roll. Many young people have said what a difference this makes to their wedding day.

Anyone living within the Ironstone Villages Family of Parishes is entitled to be married in any of the churches in the group: Stonesby, Waltham, Eaton, Eastwell, Goadby Marwood, Chadwell or Scalford.

Whilst the building work is pending at Scalford, I am asking anyone wishing to marry there to choose another of our churches 'in reserve'.

It's also worth remembering that someone who has been previously married and subsequently divorced may well be eligible to be married in church under current guidelines.

Celebrating a marriage is one of the highlights of life in our churches, and we will always try to help to make a church wedding possible. Do get in touch with Beverley or Penny at the church office if you need any further information.

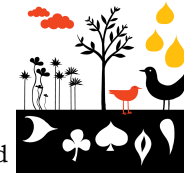

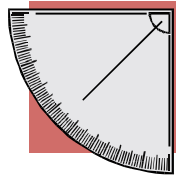

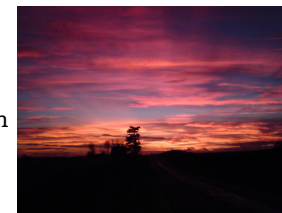
GOADBY MARWOOD
