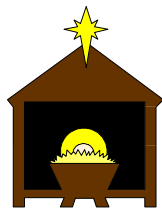

### DON'T CANCEL CHRISTMAS!

Last week on the radio I was listening to Delia Smith telling me that I could serve a 4-course Christmas dinner for under £6 per person (although it replaced the bird with turkey drumsticks in port, which I thought wouldn't be quite the same). It was part of the Radio 2 campaign "Don't cancel Christmas".

It got me thinking. How has a celebration of the love of God, incarnate in a child, born in a stable to a single mother in a strange city in an occupied territory, become something that might be cancelled because of a recession?

Don't misunderstand me. I love celebrating and love the build-up to Christmas: the carols, the excitement of the children, and the presents and cards (I even love round robin letters from old friends).



I am not making light of the very genuine suffering that has suddenly come upon an ever-widening group of people. The financial crisis is very real and will in the end, I believe, impact on everyone and every situation in our country.

However, isn't that what Christmas is all about? God's rescue package costs nothing and has no strings attached. Jesus Christ came into the world to bring good news to the poor, to bind up the broken hearted and to comfort those who mourn. All we are

asked to do in response is to kneel at his feet and worship him and in his power go out and bring light into the needy world. Cancel Christmas? Never! Bring it on, I say! - but let's begin to make better sense of it and make this year the end of the worship of consumerism and, as the carol says: "Come, come and worship Christ the Lord".

## NEW CHAMBER CHOIR

Nota Bene is a brand new Chamber Choir with a lot to offer. It was initially founded in response to a number of requests for a small-scale ensemble in which singers could really hone their performance skills. Since its inception in March 2008, the choir has blossomed, from half a dozen gentlemen who fancied having a go at barbershop singing, into a mixed choir of over 20 members.
