RESTART THE HEART

Arrhythmia Alliance, the national heart rhythm charity, is running a national campaign to place AEDs in every local community. This promotes the placement of AEDs in public places with 24hr access so that emergency life saving equipment is available to everyone whenever it is needed.

The project is unique in that the AEDs are kept in secure, weatherproof cabinets on the exterior walls of buildings, such as a post office, church, local shop, pub or village hall.

The Chew Valley in Somerset launched the first Restart the Heart initiative; successfully becoming a Heart Safe community with 20 AEDs located outdoors around the locality. With the support of Arrhythmia Alliance, there are now many more communities

following the example of the Chew Valley Model.

If you think your community would be interested, Belvoir HeartBeat can attend local meetings (e.g. Parish council, patient sessions) to present Restart the Heart and explain how to become a 'Heart Safe' community. For communities who want to proceed we can assist with organising awareness sessions and co-ordinating activities, offer fundraising ideas and press and media advice.
