PARKING IN SCALFORD

Residents are reminded that vehicles should not be parked on footpaths, and that these should be left completely clear to allow free and uninterrupted access to pedestrians, especially those in wheelchairs or those with push-chairs, etc.

BELVOIR HEARTBEAT

Belvoir HeartBeat is a scheme being promoted by Belvoir First Aid, Village Link and the medical equipment manufacturer Cardiac Science, with the support of national charities.

The aim is to introduce defibrillators into the 100 villages of the Vale and Grantham area, placing them in convenient places, eg. shop walls, pubs, churches and village halls, in order to increase the chance of survival should any-one suffer a cardiac arrest.

Belvoir HeartBeat will provide defibrillators, vandal proof boxes and training to support the scheme. The estimated cost is approximately £2,500 per unit, including all maintenance and support for seven years.

The Parish Council wonder how much local interest there would be in such a scheme, as this may be a worthwhile project to which to allocate public funds.

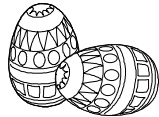

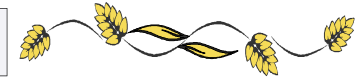
