The Revd Lawrence King

It was with very great sadness we heard that the Revd Lawrence King had died following a short illness on Easter Saturday. He was Rector of the parishes of Scalford, Goadby Marwood, Eaton and Eastwell from 1989 to 1998, living in the rectory at Scalford with his wife Barbara and son and daughter, Stephen and Elizabeth.

Those who knew him well will remember the regular weekday services, the Passover meals at the rectory, the discussion groups he led, and his visits to the homes at Scalford Court and Dovecote Lodge, Eaton. He was a great teacher, had a wide knowledge (both general and theological) and provided the opportunity for a church-centred life.

He retired to Lichfield with Barbara, who has a lovely singing voice and played the organ regularly at services here. Both Elizabeth and Stephen are now married. Stephen works as a doctor in Australia, and he and his wife, Harriet, have a daughter, Grace, around 8 months old; all three came over recently, giving Lawrence the opportunity to see his granddaughter for the first time.

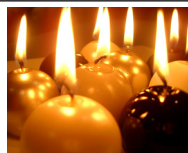
