VANDALISM IN THE VILLAGE

Last month the Parish Council asked for help in dealing with the broken fence. No one came forward and so we would like you to know what you are paying for. The Parish Council, your elected body, spends your money on facilities across the parish and alongside this the Village Hall Committee spends your donated money on recreational resources.

Vandalism in this area will now have cost the two bodies well over fifteen hundred pounds, and talks are now going on which, if implemented, will result in the purchase of closed circuit television cameras costing over two thousand pounds being installed to combat this in future. Damage has included seats, the structure of the hall, windows, etc., pipes and drains, the play equipment set on fire, the new hedges pulled up, the new fence broken—need we say more?

SCALFORD VILLAGE HALL

All hirers of the Village Hall are reminded of the necessity of obtaining a licence if it is intended either to sell alcohol at an event or include the provision of alcohol in the ticket price. The licence is obtainable from the Melton Borough Council and costs £21.

Applicants need to allow ten working days to obtain a licence before an event. The Village Hall Committee regrets it may not be able to allow an event to proceed if alcohol is being sold and a licence is not displayed.

When you visit the village hall, have a close look at what you are paying for, and decide what you'd like to do about it. Most, but not all of us, would like to see our money spent on more resources and not on putting things right.

The police are not likely to front an anti-vandalism campaign for each small item, but the sums add up when it comes to paying for the damage and measures for prevention.

If the offenders are caught and appear in court they can be required to pay for the damage and be sentenced, but this needs competent witnesses to come forward.

With lighter nights, more activities at the hall and on the recreation area, we must all be observant and make an effort to put an end to this antisocial behaviour now. If you are concerned about going to the level of the Magistrates Court, alternatively Civil Court action is possible and costs can be awarded.

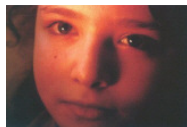

FRIENDS OF CHERNOBYL'S CHILDREN

PLEASE CAN YOU HELP?

We are hosts for the Friends of Chernobyl Children's Charity (East Leicestershire). The children come to the United Kingdom from Belarus for a month a year for 5 years. The visit improves their life expectancy as well as providing a number of opportunities and experiences they would otherwise not encounter. The children are still affected by the Chernobyl Disaster which happened over 20 years ago. They eat few fruit and vegetables and drink little or no milk as in their country it is contaminated.

They come from very poor backgrounds. When they arrive in England they usually have very few clothes, often arriving with a small rucksack or even a carrier bag. There will be 10-12 in the group that comes in September this year. We are looking for donations of any autumn or winter clothes suitable for girls and boys between the ages of 7 and 10 that you or friends and family may no longer need.

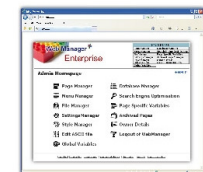

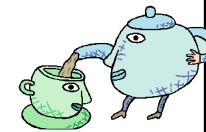

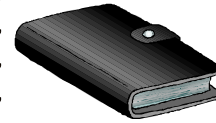
