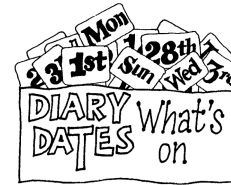
September is Older Persons' Month!

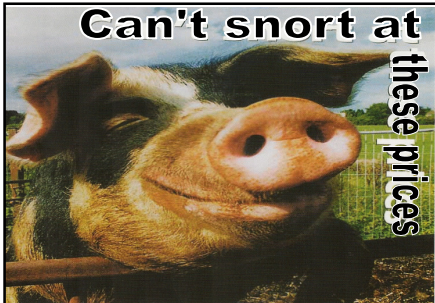
