"Hello Everyone,

I was pleasantly surprised at the number of you (16 or 17) expressing an interest in the Village History Group and I feel that it would be a good idea to arrange a meeting to re-convene the group as there are only two or three of us left from the late 1990's. I am the only signatory to the Bank Account for instance and that needs changing as I am at the age when anything could happen. As I live at Cropwell Bishop, it would be helpful if one of you who is aware of the goings on in the village could arrange a meeting date and I would go along with that.

I now have the copies of the reprinted version of Aspects of Eastwell and at £7.00 (compared with £9.00 for the 2001 version), the printing cost should be covered after we have sold 100 of the 200 copies.

For the future, I would like to pass on the knowledge I have gained of the village over my lifetime, together with the associated printed references, maps, photos etc. Would a series of meetings where we discussed different periods and the evidence for them, be a way to achieve this?

I look forward to receiving your comments on these proposals. Please let others, who may not be on email, know of these suggestions.

LONG CLAWSON SURGERY

Patient Participation Group—Bowel Cancer

Dr Rathbone has written an article which the Long Clawson Surgery have asked to be included. However, it is rather too long for this publication, so it has been edited to fit this space. If you would like a copy of the full article, maybe you could get in touch with the surgery.

Screening. Since 2006 the NHS has been offering screening to people aged 60-69, and it is planned to offer screening routinely to people aged 70-74 by 2014. There are around 34,900 new cases each year in the UK, resulting in 16,100 deaths from the disease. It has been estimated that screening could reduce the number of deaths in people aged 60-69 by 16%. Screening is offered by post and your GP is not involved, but will only be notified once the result is available. If you wish you can call 0800 707 6060 to receive a kit.

The chances of the test being positive are around 2/100; a positive result means further tests are offered; of the further tests offered, 90% prove NOT to be cancer.

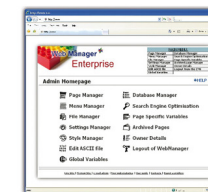

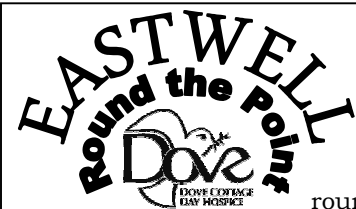
