LONG CLAWSON SURGERY PATIENT PARTICIPATION GROUP



I'm Lynne Marshall and the current Chairperson of the
Long Clawson Medical Practice Patient Participation Group. We've
been running for a year now and I thought it might be useful to tell you a little
bit about the work we have been doing and our plans for 2011.

Our Group exists to represent your views as a patient of the Surgery and to work
on your behalf to improve the services available to you.

Last year was very much about setting up the Group with its own Constitution
and establishing members with an interest in working together to support
patient's requirements. We now have a great group of people from all walks of
life willing to give up their time to contribute and help. We meet once a month
at the Surgery.

You may have come across PPG members at the Flu Clinics held in 2010 as we
introduced ourselves to as many of you as we could. We had some great feed-
back and suggestions from you and will certainly be at the 2011 Flu Clinics.
We have also helped to improve the information on the TV monitor in the
Surgery to make sure that it is relevant and gives useful and practical informa-
tion about up and coming services and events. We will be looking at ways to

We suggested a direct advice telephone line into the Pharmacy and this is being
well used for patients seeking advice from the Pharmacist. We will also be
putting up a notice board in the Surgery so that you can see the ongoing work
that we are doing.

Our goal for early 2011 is to carry out a Patient Questionnaire to find out what
you would most like to see introduced at the Surgery. We have had lots of
ideas but we need to hear your views to make sure that we are on the right
track. We will then select the most popular ideas and work with the Surgery
to see them happen! We will publish the results and continue to let you know
what we are doing through the Parish Magazines.
