

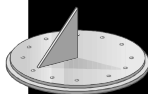

We are hosts for the Friends of Chernobyl Children's Charity (East Leicestershire). The children come to the United Kingdom from Belarus for a month a year for 5 years. This is the group's 4th visit to Leicestershire.

The visit improves their life expectancy as well as providing a number of opportunities and experiences they would otherwise not encounter. The children are still affected by the Chernobyl Disaster which happened over 20 years ago. They eat few fruit and vegetables and drink little or no milk, as in their country it is contaminated.

The children come from very poor backgrounds. When they arrive in England they usually have very few clothes, often arriving with a small rucksack or even a carrier bag. This year the group comes in June.

We are looking for donations of any clothes suitable for girls and boys between the ages of 9 and 14 that you or your friends and family may no longer need.

Residents are often pressured or intimidated into accepting a poor standard of work for an extortionate cost. Work is often unnecessary and sometimes money is paid for work that hasn't been done.

Advice to all residents is always: (1) do not open the door to unexpected callers; (2) do not let strangers into your home; (3) do not be pressured into buying goods and services on the doorstep; (4) remember, rogue traders use glossy printed leaflets and wear smart clothes; (5) IF IN DOUBT, KEEP THEM OUT! If you suspect rogue trading in your area, please call the Citizens Advice Consumer Helpline and Trading Standards on 0854 04 05 08.
