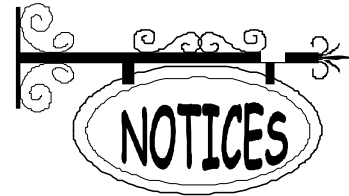

## LONG CLAWSON

### SURGERY Patient Participation Group

#### Annual General Meeting

This was held on 20th November in Long Clawson Village Hall and was attended by 31 patients and staff. Joanne Truscott from the Alzheimer's Society gave a most informative talk, explaining how to recognise the symptoms of Alzheimers and how they differ from the normal ageing process. This was well received by those present and generally agreed that more such informative talks would benefit patients.

#### Waste not, want not

Paul Zivtins, the Superintendent Pharmacist at LCMP Pharmacy, spoke at our November meeting about the problem of medical wastage of prescriptions. His figures were somewhat startling. The annual costs to the NHS are:

- Medicines returned to pharmacies £110 million
- Unused prescriptions stored at home £90 million
- Medicines disposed of by Care Homes £50 million
- Annual estimated cost to NHS £300 million

This £300 million could have paid for:

- 80,906 hip replacements
- 101,351 knee replacements
- 19,799 drug treatment courses for breast cancer
- 300,000 drug treatment courses for Alzheimer's disease

#### How does this happen?

Patients may receive medicines they no longer use, need or only use occasionally. Not taking medications as prescribed can result in patients not getting the required health benefits of the prescription.

Audits have shown that around half of medication returned has not even been opened. Even if unopened, all medications returned after leaving the pharmacy have to be destroyed; they cannot be recycled or prescribed to anyone else.

### SCALFORD POOR'S LAND CHARITY

Scalford Poor's Land Charity is a charity local to Scalford Parish. Over the years the Charity has evolved from an organisation for the relief of the poor of the Parish to one that now has a wider remit. The Trustees are able to spend the income on a range of purposes for the general good of the residents of the Parish.

One of the original aims of the Charity was the provision of aid for sick, convalescent, disabled or infirm persons and this is still the case. With this in mind the Trustees wish to publish the availability of small grants from the Charity for such persons. These grants are solely at the discretion of the Trustees and dependent on the funds available at the time of application.

The Trustees' aim is to provide help where it is not already available from any other agency. This could include such things as the provision of a piece of equipment, help with travelling costs to hospital appointments or a donation towards the cost of short term respite care.

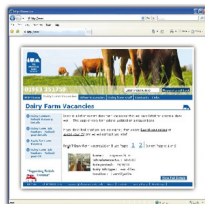

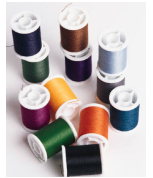
