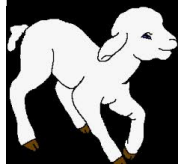

One query brought up in the recent survey was the limit of two problems which a patient might bring up in a booked appointment. Patients may reasonably think that they are saving time in doing this both for themselves and the doctor. The reason for each consultation being timed for ten minutes is to maximise the number of booked appointments available for early evening surgery. Obviously, if a patient brings a list of problems to the consultation, it will delay the process and patients with appointments after them will be kept waiting. **Should you feel you need more time, it is possible to ask for a double slot of twenty minutes.** To help the system run efficiently, it is important to remember to keep appointments. Patients who fail to do so prevent another patient from having that appointment. If you cannot make your appointment, please inform the surgery as soon as possible.

**BROADBAND IN RURAL AREAS**

There has been considerable talk about the roll out of superfast broadband across the UK but until recently the timings for the final 8%, which are predominantly rural areas, has been unclear.

Leicestershire County Council awarded the contract for superfast broadband delivery to BT and then ceased any activity to support community projects until BT were clear on their timetable and plans within this contract.

We now have greater, though not full, detail from BT and the village of Eaton, serviced by the Knipton exchange, will **not be upgraded until late 2015/March 2016**. Even then this will only take cable to the exchange in Knipton and there are no plans to upgrade the cabling from there to be village - the main impact on speed given it is so far away.

**There is no confirmation of what levels of service improvement these changes will deliver.**

Eastwell is in a similar position with the Harby exchange.

In order to make decisions on whether we lobby harder with Leicestershire County Council or go it alone and find interim or alternative solutions, your views are needed.

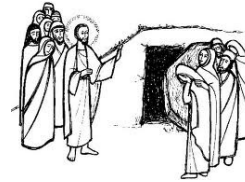

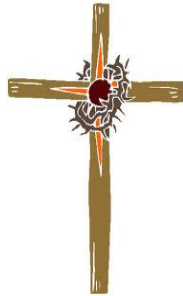
