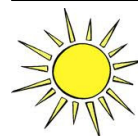

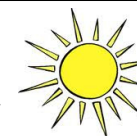

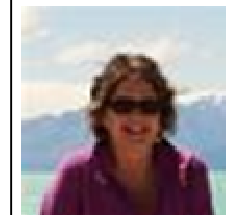
There have been several organised rides passing through these villages over the past few weeks, causing some disruption to traffic: there are also reports of rudeness by some of the cyclists.

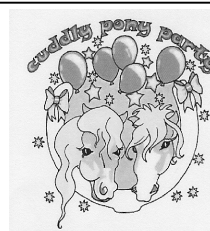

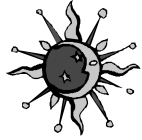
