The Leicestershire Advice Service for Social Care is a new service commissioned by Leicestershire County Council, LCPT (formerly Leicestershire Community Projects Trust), in partnership with The Carers Centre, is delivering the service.

The free, independent and confidential service is for all adults who live in Leicestershire County and need information and advice about social care. The information can be for yourself, a relative, friend or neighbour or if you are a professional you can request information for someone you are supporting.

The need to access social care services can be a daunting process. The Leicestershire Advice Service team can ease the pressure by researching what help, support, activities etc., are available and how to access these. This can include things like how to get a Community Care Assessment, how to get an impact of Caring Assessment, and the details of different services and activities offered by the local authority, voluntary organisations and businesses. If we don't have the answer immediately available we will investigate for you.

Advice is normally offered by telephone: however, alternative arrangements will be made when the telephone is not a suitable option. 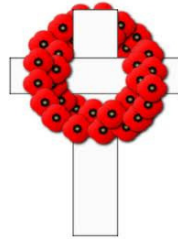
