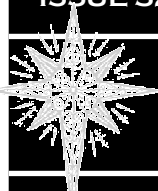

**VALE POLICING WITH PCSO LIAM PALMER****Volunteers required for new police advisory group**

Do you live in Melton and want to learn more about policing and help shape what happens in your community? We are looking for 15 people to join a new police advisory group which is being set up to offer residents the chance to find out about how the police works and become the voice of the community they live in.

As a member of the group you will be able to feed in community concerns and shape and influence what's happening in your local area. You will also be called upon in serious incidents to gauge community feeling and help feedback reassurance message to the people affected.

*Neighbourhood Policing Commander for the Eastern Counties, Inspector Gavin Drummond, said: "This is a great opportunity for members of the public to gain a greater understanding of how the police work and the types of jobs that we get involved in.*

*"There is a lot more to our job than just dealing with crime and we hope that by giving group members this insight they will become ambassadors for the force and be able to explain to people within their communities why things might be dealt with differently to how they think they should be.*

*"We will also look to them for feedback on how we could do things differently and for advice on the service they would expect to receive if they were a victim of crime".*

Becoming a member will involve completing a seven-week training programme which will cover a range of police functions and roles, including crime prevention, incident recording, road safety, forensic investigations, police use of dogs and firearms, internet safety, the role of the Dedicated Neighbourhood Teams, as well as other key departments.

Once the training has been completed, new members will be approached on an ad hoc basis to discuss local incidents and crime with the opportunity to become a police volunteer.

If you live in Melton or the Vale of Belvoir, are at least 18 years old and would like to apply to be part of this exciting venture, email [ecpoliceadvisor@leicestershire.pnn.police.uk](mailto:ecpoliceadvisor@leicestershire.pnn.police.uk) for more information or to request an application form. The deadline for applications is Friday, 18th December 2015, and successful applicants will be subject to security checks.

Training sessions for successful applicants will take place between 6.00 pm to 8.00 pm on a Wednesday evening at The Venue, Phoenix House, Nottingham Road, Melton Mowbray. The first session is due to start in March next year.

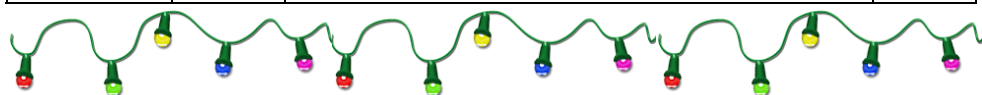

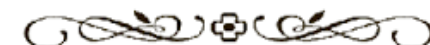

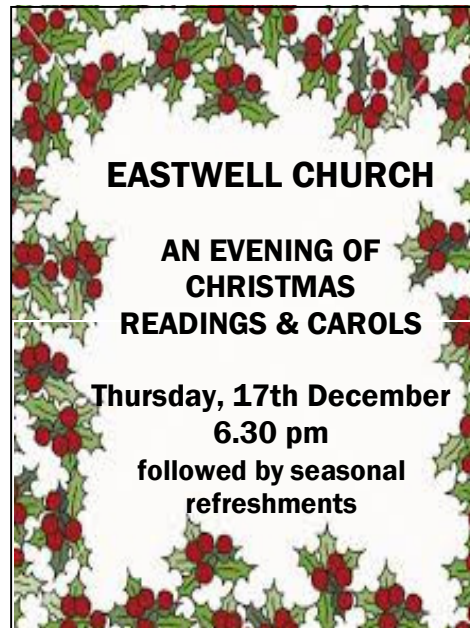
