

## VALE POLICING WITH PCSO PALMER



Over recent months the offence of Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) has been highlighted in the press. CSE affects children and young people of all backgrounds and from all communities. It happens when people have power or influence over a young person and use this to sexually abuse them. This power or influence can be due to a person being older, of a different gender, a higher intellect, being stronger, or having a greater financial position amongst many more.

The child may be targeted due to a vulnerability which the offender can exploit. This involves the offender manipulating the child to get what they want, by offering something that a child or young person may want or need. This could be accommodation, gifts, cigarettes, alcohol or just a greater amount of attention. They may be singled out and targeted online, or face to face. Some children may have greater vulnerability and be more at risk, but no child is immune.

Some children can be groomed by the offender who will then introduce sexual activity through force, coercion, or by making the child believe that "it is part of the deal". Because of the length of time that some children are groomed, they may not realise they are becoming a victim or in some cases may blame themselves for becoming a victim.

For parents and guardians it is important that you remain vigilant around those who have access to your child, monitoring online access and physical access, and keeping an open dialogue with your child which will allow them to tell you if they are worried about anything that is happening to them. Demonstrate to your child that it is alright for them to say no. Explain to them what is classed as risky behaviour, such as communication on-line or meeting with people in person who

they do not really know. Also the sharing of personal information on-line can increase risk considerably and certainly images or selfies should only be sent to known and trusted contacts and should never be sexual or indecent.

Advise them that if they think something is wrong that they should speak to you or another adult they can trust, even if they have not been able to say no at the time. Look out for: unexplained gifts, changes in mood, going missing, staying out late. secrecy about where they are going, lack of interest in activities and hobbies, truancy from school,



## HARVEST TIME



"The Goadby Marwood PCC and congregation recognise the need to support the food bank in Melton Mowbray for those who are in financial distress.

Although we have a food box permanently in the church for gifts to be made by the parish, it was considered over the last two vears that this should be boosted by the funds raised from the auction of the products after the Harvest Festival Service. The total amount made available over the two year period was approximately £340, and following each Harvest Festival, Barbara and I have arranged with the Food Bank representatives to meet us at Tesco's to tour the supermarket, in order that they can select the most appropriate produce needed at that time.

They are most keen to select items which could be split into various packets for a more wider distribution, together with prepared meals, tinned vegetables and desserts. They specifically did not want any baked beans because they have plenty of stock, as more people tend to give baked beans than any other product!

*If anyone reading the above wishes to* donate any item of food, then items such as Penguins or small chocolate rolls and biscuits are always very welcome for children, and tinned fruits, prepared meals and vegetables for adults. Items with a fairly reasonable life are preferred to those which have only a few days, or a week's life.

*The representatives were very grateful for* the donation, and other parishes in the group may wish to consider donating any of their spare funds towards this cause."



A fun day out Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> August from noon


Stathern Lodge, Canal Lane, Stathern, LE14 4EX - Free entry
