Departures, Arrivals and Waiting Rooms ...

Dear Reader of the Village News,

By the time that you read this, Mary and I should be unpacking at our new home in Waltham on the Wolds. Yet at the time of writing this article, we have still to celebrate Easter, and there is so much more sorting out to do before we move from Malvern!

We are preparing for our departure from a people and place that we have come to know and love, with all the goodbyes that this involves. At the same time, we are also looking forward to our arrival at a new destination, with all the people and places that we shall get to know in Leicestershire.

At the moment it is a bit like being in a waiting room, as we prepare to embark on an exciting new journey of discovery.

Waiting rooms are not always exciting, are they?! Sometimes they can be places of fear and anxiety, for example when we are awaiting the results of a medical test for ourselves or for a loved one, or to be called to see the dentist to undergo dental treatment.

Waiting rooms can also be places of uncertainty, and an uncomfortable reminder that many important things in life are out of our control. Yet we also know what a difference it can make if someone is alongside, to support and encourage us.

Later this month, Christians celebrate an event that is also about a departure, an arrival, and a waiting room. Ascension Day (25th May) marks the departure of the Risen Christ, and the promise of the arrival of the Holy Spirit.

On Good Friday, the first followers of Jesus had watched Him die on a cross, and had mourned His death. Then they had rejoiced to see Him alive again, and for 40 days the Risen Lord had been with them and had taught them more about God's Kingdom

Now Jesus was leaving them again, as He returned to God the Father. However, He also assured them that they would now come to know Him in a new way, through the gift of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit would make the presence of Jesus real to them at all times, and in all places. In the meantime, they had to wait for God's promise to be fulfilled - as it wonderfully was on the first Day of Pentecost, and has been ever since.

Whatever departures, arrivals and waiting rooms we have to face, may you and I know that we are not on our own. I am very much looking forward to the end of my present 'waiting room', and to my 'arrival' on 23rd May as your new Rector.

We now await the coming of the hawthorn or the May to be followed by displays of dog roses and elderflowers. When Kathleen and I are not too busy we like to be able to sit and to contemplate the beauty of nature around us, to pause and to reflect on what has been happening. Modern living styles encourage us to live life at a fast pace, dashing from one thing to another. Spaces for being still and reflective are not usually part of the order of the day! In a previous Circuit one Church had a banner with these words:

Be still and know that I am God

When we are living life at a fast pace it is easy to forget God. It is a good idea, as Jesus found during his busy ministry, to be still and see what God might be trying to say. There is a Japanese version of the 23rd Psalm which begins with these words:

*The Lord is my Pace-Setter I shall not rush
He makes me stop and rest for quiet intervals.
He provides me with images of stillness ... which restores my serenity.*

It is important that in our busy lives we do find time to be still before God - on Sundays, meeting with other Christians in Bible groups and in our own quiet moments. This does not mean that God is absent with us when we are busy, but it is important that there are times in our lives when we are still and listen to what God may have to say to us and perhaps be surprised by what we hear.

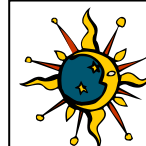
