Letter from the Rector

A winning Team? ...

Dear Reader of the Village News,

I'm writing this a couple of days before the start of the 2018 World Cup in Russia. It is one of those 'Marmite' events - some (including myself) will really enjoy the next few weeks of extra football coverage, and others will be counting down the days until the World Cup ends on 15th July! And if you're reading this in early July, will England still be in the tournament?!

Whichever national team emerges victorious at the World Cup Final, one thing is certain. That group of soccer players - together with their coaches and supporting staff - will have shown great teamwork. And- as the inspiring example of Leicester City from a few seasons ago reminds us - it is not always a team full of individual stars that comes out on top - great teamwork can make all the difference.

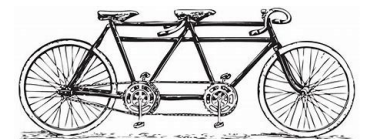

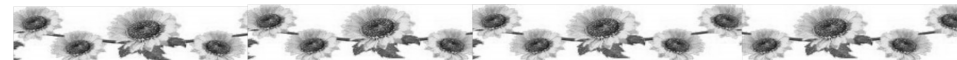
