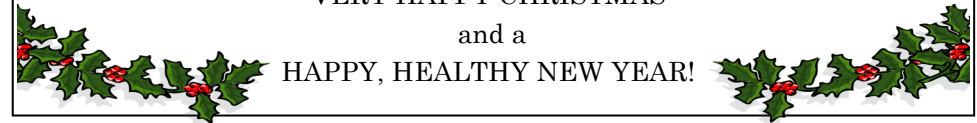

## Letter from the Rector

### The Birth of Hope ....

Dear Friends,

What might you be hoping for this Christmas? Given all the Covid restrictions we had over the Christmas period last year, perhaps our hope this year is simply to be able to share the festive season with loved ones - something that we cannot take for granted, given the pandemic experience we've had over the past couple of years. And maybe some of us also hope that the food supply chains are working well enough for us to enjoy the usual seasonal fare. And that's not to mention what Santa might bring .....!

Whatever our Christmas hopes, some of them may well not be realised. For example, my wife Mary and I won't be able to have our usual family gathering at Christmas, as health concerns will prevent some family members we had hoped to see from joining us.

For many of us, Christmas will also highlight the absence of departed loved ones, those with whom we have enjoyed sharing Christmases gone by.

A few days before Christmas - on Sunday 19th December at 10.30 am - we shall be holding a Service of Remembering in Eastwell church, at which we shall be invited to light a candle for those who we hold in loving memory especially at this time.

Hope is rather like lighting a candle. A candle brings light to all around it - the shining light of hope to dispel the darkness. At Christmas we often brighten the dark December days with colourful Christmas lights in our streets,

shops and homes. Yet at the heart of Christmas, we are invited to discover another light - the light of a God-given hope that cannot be extinguished.

In celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ as a baby in Bethlehem, Christians celebrate the coming among us of "the true light that gives light to everyone", the One whose "light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it" (John 1. 5,9). The same Jesus who said this of Himself: "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life" (John 8.12).

There is a lovely Christmas song by Graham Kendrick which begins as follows ...

Like a candle flame,  
Flickering small in our darkness,  
Uncreated light shines through infant eyes.  
*God is with us, alleluia.*  
*Come to save us, alleluia.*

Wishing you Christmas joy and peace as we celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ, the light of God-given hope which cannot be extinguished.

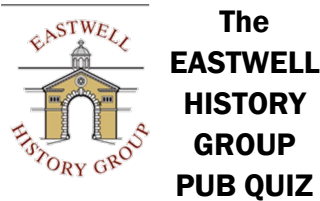
