Letter from the Rector

Who knows? ...

Dear Friends,

One of the challenges of writing an article several weeks before publication - as I am with this article just before Easter - is not knowing what will be happening at the time it finally appears - alas, I don't have a crystal ball!

Who knows, for example, whether the war in the Ukraine will have escalated, or whether a negotiated settlement can be reached? Who knows whether coronavirus infection rates and numbers of Covid-related hospitalisations and deaths will fall significantly, or keep on rising? Who knows how badly people will be affected by the increased cost of living, or whether there will be more tangible help for those struggling to buy food, fuel and other basic necessities?

Another 'who knows' is what church life, ministry and mission will look like when our churches eventually become part of Minster Communities in the Diocese of Leicester. Meanwhile we are asked to consider prayerfully together the Shaped By God Discussion Starter questions, and to have conversations about these as local churches over the coming months.

Who knows? There are so many questions to which we do not know the answers. Instead - and in the face of all life's uncertainty - we are invited to trust the One who knows the future, and who holds us in His care, come what may. Jesus told His followers not to worry about tomorrow, but to live in the present moment.

I'm reminded of the following song (*by Andy Irons/RESOUNDworship.org,admin. The Jubilate Group*) that I've come across in primary school gatherings:

Who knows the number of hairs on my head?
 Who understands my fears?
 Who knows my dreams when I sleep in my bed?
 Who's counted all my tears?
 Who knows my life, every night, every day?
 Who's always here with me?
 Who knows my words, everything that I say?
 Who sees the things I see?
 God knows everything about me,
 God knows everything about me,
 He knows everything about me,
 And God loves me.

In the light of Easter, may you and I be assured that we can trust our future to the God who knows us, and who shows us His undying love in Jesus Christ.

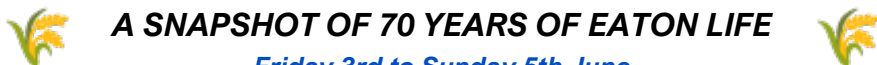

QUEEN ELIZABETH II's JUBILEE**EASTWELL CELEBRATIONS**

To celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee on Thursday 2nd June, Trevor Rowbotham has been successful in applying to have a beacon at the top of his fields overlooking Harby Hill, which will be lit at 9.45 pm.

The whole village will be invited to join at around 9.00 pm and watch the beacons lit from the hill, sing God save the Queen, and say a small prayer together.

To complement this, it seemed to be a good chance to have a get-together for all ages in the village earlier in the day to re-connect with old friends and meet some of the new residents that we haven't met yet. The early proposal is:

- A children's entertainer and tea, to take place between 2.30 and 5.00 pm, primarily pitched at the under 10s.
- An early evening get together between 6.00 and 9.00 pm for all ages, to include music through the decades of the Queen's reign, hot dogs, vegan paella, desserts/cheese board, a bar, a display of photographs from the Queen's reign depicting life in the village during this time.
- 9.00 pm+: to move to the top of the hill for the beacon lighting, either by foot or car.

The Village Hall is an ideal location for this event and the committee are in agreement that it would be great to get this booked in and advertised as soon as possible.

An application to the MBC for a grant towards the cost is being made, and the plan is to not charge entry fee, but funds will be raised through the sale of the food and the bar. As the Village Hall finances appear to be in good shape, the committee are happy that any money raised goes to the church.





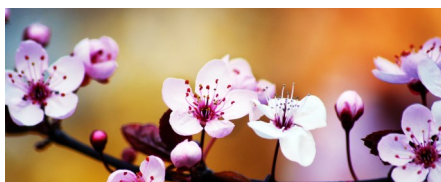
