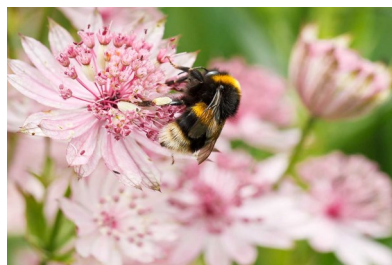

Letter from the Rector**Our Faithful Queen**

Dear Friends,

On 6th February 2022, the
seventieth anniversary
of her accession, Her
Majesty the Queen
became the first British Monarch to
celebrate a Platinum Jubilee.



This month, we are celebrating the Jubilee in
a variety of ways across our villages,
including holding special services and
exhibitions, community picnics and parties,
and by the lighting of a beacon. And - as
someone who enjoys puddings - I am also
glad to see that there will even be a Platinum
Pudding Party on Pentecost in Scalford
Church!

During the past seventy years, the Queen
has given us a shining example of service,
commitment, discretion, loyalty, resilience,
modesty, and of a sense of duty.

As well as being Head of State, the Queen is
Supreme Governor of the Church of
England. Hers is a sacramental role - apart
from the Pope, the Queen is the only
Christian monarch who has been anointed to
her task. For the Queen, this is clearly not
just about ceremonial, but about a Christian
faith which is a deep and personal reality.

In her Christmas message in the year 2000,
the Queen bore witness to her faith in these
words: "For me the teachings of Christ and
my personal accountability before God
provide a framework in which I try to lead
my life. I Have drawn great comfort in
difficult times from Christ's words and
example".

The Queen is someone who seeks to live
her life in the light of Jesus Christ, the
Saviour sent from God. As she said in her
Christmas broadcast of 2011: "Although we
are capable of great acts of kindness, history
teaches us that we sometimes need saving
from ourselves - from our recklessness and
greed. God sent into the world a unique
person - neither a philosopher nor a
general .. but a Saviour, with the power to
forgive".

During this month, we shall be using the
following prayer of thanksgiving for our
faithful Queen. It is a prayer which you and
I can also make our own:

*Gracious God, we give you thanks
for the reign of your servant*

Elizabeth our Queen,

and for the example of

loving and faithful service

which she has shown among us.

Help us to follow her example of dedication

*and to commit our lives to you and to one
another, through Jesus Christ our Lord.*

Amen.

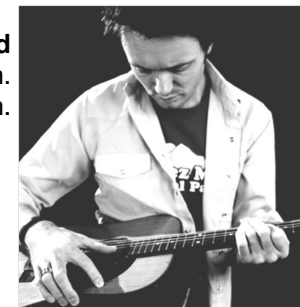
