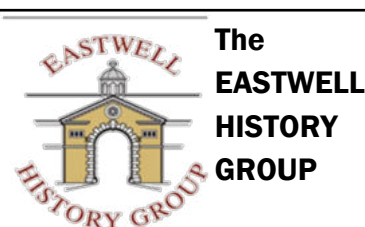
**A talk on the Special Operations Executive in WWII** with specialised research into the contributions made by support staff and the female agents of the French section (F section)

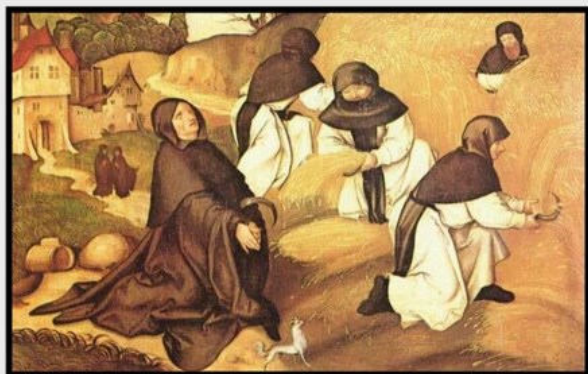

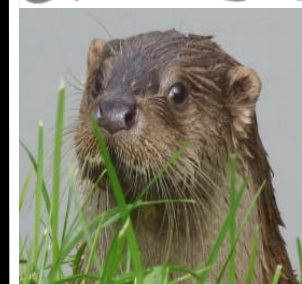
