to be followed by a last meeting in 2023 on **Monday, 11th December**, and, as always, members of the public are very welcome.

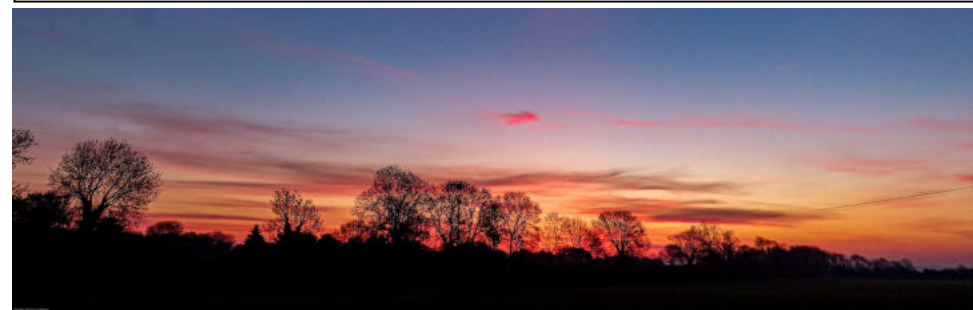
These are important meetings for two reasons.

Letter from the Rector

A lasting legacy ...

Dear friends,

What would you like to be remembered for? During November we reflect on some different types of legacy handed onto us by others.

The month begins with All Saints Day (1st November), when the Church remembers those who have let the light of God's love shine through their lives in a way that continues to inspire others to follow Jesus Christ. Then, on All Souls' Day (2nd November) we remember departed loved ones and hold them in loving memory. This year, there is an opportunity for us to do so together at a special Service of Remembering in St Denys Church, Eaton, at 7.00 pm.

A few days later, on Armistice Day (Saturday, 11th) and Remembrance Sunday (12th) - as well as around that period - many services will be held to remember those who have laid down their lives for king and country in time of war, and to reflect on the legacy they have bequeathed to us through their costly sacrifice.

What others have done, and their inspiring example, has the power to change the way we choose to live.


For example, legacies left to our local churches has enabled significant work to be done to

Some of you will know that our daughter Gillian has been diagnosed with, and is being treated for, Cholangiocarcinoma, cancer of the bile duct in the liver. This is a rare illness and is difficult to treat. Gill has two daughters, aged five and three, and is working with University College Hospital London on trials for the development of more focussed medication as an alternative to the chemotherapy she is currently subject to. You may also be aware that I have recently been hospitalised with a liver illness from which I am recovering.

The national organisation, *British Liver Trust*, has designated October as *Liver Cancer Awareness Month* with a series of coffee mornings to raise public awareness of liver disease and to remove the stigma that liver disorders are largely self-inflicted.
