Letter from the Rector

VE Day 80 - Let Us Remember

Dear Friends,

Thursday, 8th May marks the 80th anniversary of VE Day - the Second World War allied victory in Europe. On that day, and the days just before and after it, events will take place to remember this historic milestone. For example at 9.30 pm on the evening of Thursday 8th, an act of remembering with beacons and candles being lit will take place across the country, representing the 'light of peace' that emerged from the dreadful darkness of war.

It is right to remember those who gave their lives at home and abroad, whose sacrifice enables us to all enjoy the peace we have today. Right to remember too those who came home, wounded, physically and mentally, and the friends and family who cared for them. Right to remember also the families that lost husbands, wives, sons, daughters and sweethearts,, and the servicemen and women of other nationalities and faiths from Commonwealth and allied countries who fought, suffered and died during six years of war.

And included in our remembrance should be those in reserved occupations and the brave people who kept us safe on the home front: doctors and nurses who cared for the wounded, the men and women who toiled in the fields and veterinary teams, the fisherman who fished the seas, those who worked in the factories and the air-raid wardens, the

police officers, firemen, ambulance drivers and the young people of the Scouts and Guides who also played such a vital role in the war effort at home.

So many people were in some way affected by - and involved in - the events of the Second World War. VE Day (and soon after VJ Day) came as a result of great sacrifice. As we remember those sacrifices, anyone unable to join in the outdoor gatherings on 8th May is encouraged to light a candle of peace at home at 9.30 pm, joining with others in praying for peace in current situations of conflict in our world.

In this Easter season, Christians continue to celebrate the hope of true and enduring peace that God has given us through Jesus Christ. He is the One whose death and resurrection has overcome the power of evil, sin and death. His light shines in the darkness of our world, and the darkness has not overcome it. And it is in His light that we can see - and share in - the life of God's Kingdom, where love reigns.




