Parishioners might remember that at two previous meetings councillors considered the possibility of an Eaton Neighbourhood Plan. Although it is yet to be confirmed at the July meeting, this venture now looks unlikely to happen.

And the reason for such a decision is important for parishioners to consider.

Namely the Government's decision to axe funding for Neighbourhood Planning. The Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government's (MHCLG) has decided to stop funding for the neighbourhood planning support programme. This decision is seen as a significant setback for localism and the highly successful neighbourhood planning initiative, which saw parish and town councils at the heart of the 2,400 communities, with more than 1,000 plans approved at referendum.

Whilst various bodies such as SLCC, NALC and Locality (the membership organisation commissioned by MHCLG to deliver the support programme), are making representations to the Government the decision is unlikely to be changed.

Eaton could still pursue such a venture but would now be faced with making up the approximate £18,000 shortfall that arises from the funding cut.

But for those unfortunate parishes midway through the process of obtaining such a plan (and remember we learnt that, for example, it was a three year exercise for neighbouring Waltham on the Wolds), there is no funding available to complete their submissions (in the clerk's view a quite scandalous situation).

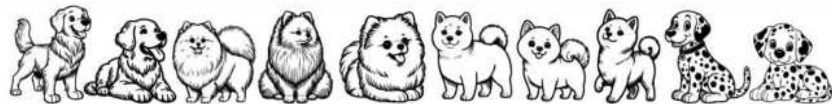

Letter from the Rector**Transitions, and moving on ...**

Dear Friends,

Our lives are marked by many different transitions. These are important moments, as we journey from the old and familiar to the new and unfamiliar. Whether it's moving home, leaving or starting a job, retiring, getting married, ending a relationship, facing ill health, or experiencing loss through bereavement, our lives are punctuated by significant endings and beginnings.

Each of them matters in the story of our lives, and we often mark them in some way. This marking of the transition might include a gathering with speeches, gifts and cards, and maybe a service with special prayers or symbolic acts.

Transitions can be stressful experiences, and it is good to prepare for them whenever possible. For example, during the past few months Year 6 children at our two primary schools in Scalford and Waltham have been thinking about what it will mean for them to move on from primary to secondary school.

They have spent time at their new school, and have had opportunities to reflect on how they are feeling about the prospect of this significant change in their lives. Then, at the start of this month - on Wednesday 0th July at Scalford and Thursday 10th July at Waltham - they will be the focus of the annual leavers service.

During this service, Year 6 children will share memories of their time at the school, and how they are feeling about moving on. The rest of the school community then say farewell to them, thank them for their contribution to the life of the school, and pray for them.

It is always a very moving occasion, one where both smiles and tears are never far away, and a good supply of tissues needs to be close at hand!

One of the hymns sometimes sung at leavers services - and indeed at other services marking transitions, such as christenings and weddings - is 'One More Step' by Sydney Carter. This hymn pictures life as a journey, and it is a prayer that we might know God's presence with us along the way. The chorus of the hymn puts it in these words:

*And it's from the old I travel to the new;
Keep me travelling along with you.*

With prayers and all good wishes as we journey on into the summer,

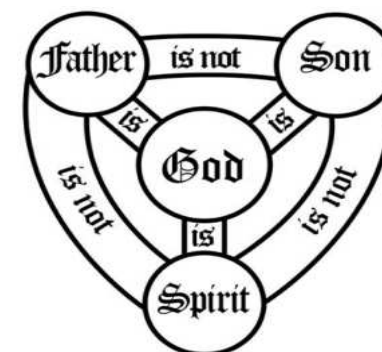

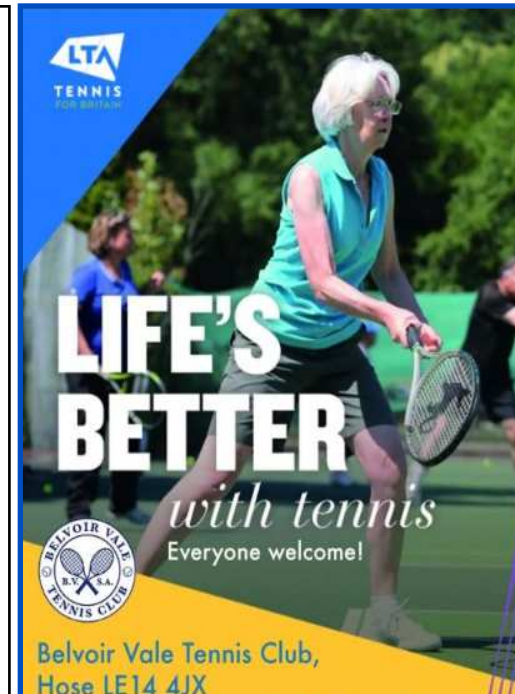
